Do not be afraid ...



'Can you not buy two sparrows for a penny? And yet not one falls to the ground without your Father knowing'. With these words of encouragement, we can confidently welcome 12th Sunday in Ordinary Time and renew our 'Yes' to our basic Christian vocation: 'to broadcast the gospel'. Of course, there isn't really such a thing as "ordinary" time, each moment of each day is unique; there has neither been, nor will there ever be another like it. Each moment is therefore precious – a gift from God. We may interpret this as symbolic of the journey of our lives, which can be rent by sudden storms – tragedy, loss, anxiety, illness: we have to listen to the voice of Jesus, who is in the journey with us, he shares our anxiety and loss and we turn to hear him say to us: 'Do not be afraid'. Think about one thing you are concerned about today and say a prayer to Jesus about it but don't forget to say 'thank you' for the good times.
