# **Data Protection - Your Information**

I. To ensure that the parish meets the requirements of the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) we will be sending an email to everyone on the parish database for whom we have an email address. It will have a heading 'SACRED HEART WIMBLEDON, Data protection'. This will enable you to confirm the information we hold on you and how you would like to be contacted in future. 2. If you do not have an email address you can request a report on the personal data we hold on you. 3. If you have received the email and you are already registered, please log on and check your personal details and also tick the boxes for the forms of communication you wish us to use in future. Once registered, you can change your options at any time. 4. If you are not registered, then please follow the steps in 7 below. 5. Since the database has not been fully tested it may be that your email address has been incorrectly entered. 6. If you think you should have received an email, please first check your spam/junk mailbox. The email address for the church website is website@sacredheartwimbledon.org.uk. 7. If you have not received an email, then you can apply to register on the website yourself by going to https://sacredheartwimbledon.org.uk and clicking on the 'Register' tab on the top righthand corner. You no longer need to fill in a registration card. 8. We encourage 'self registration' as it helps to ensure that the information is correct and up to date. 9. You will be sent an acknowledgement. Your application is then reviewed, and you will then be sent an email with login details and a password. This may take a few days as this part of the process is not automatic. 10. When you then log in you will be able to check your personal details and amend them as necessary. Very importantly, you will also be able to opt in for which forms of communication you wish the parish to use in contacting you. We do ask that whenever possible you include the option of using email. II. If you receive an email and are no longer a member of the parish or do not want your personal details held on the database, please let us know and they will be deleted permanently. 12. If we do not receive a response to emails which have been delivered, then we are required to delete the record. 13. Before doing so, we will send at least one reminder. 14.
