## **Introducing Eleanor and Kelly**

We are really looking forward to working in the parish and wanted to introduce ourselves. We have spent the last month preparing our plans and getting to know the parish and are very thankful for the warm welcome we have received.

Eleanor - I come from a background of youth ministry starting out in a Catholic residential Centre. During my time at 1 worked University closely with the chaplaincy team to reach out to students of all faiths and none. I then spent a year working for a Catholic charity that equips Catholic parishes to reach out and meet vulnerable young people in their own context. I am excited to be working here and have contacting started the



schools in order to create relationships with students. I am looking forward to setting up youth groups for primary and secondary aged children along with supporting the existing young adults' group.

Kelly – I come from a background of teaching Sixth Form students Philosophy of Religion and Ethics and have been a member of this parish for ten years. In the last two years I have found myself deepening my faith during retreats and often with the support of members of the parish who spoke enthusiastically about their faith. I am delighted to now be working for the parish initially on the First Holy Communion and Confirmation programmes along with a programme for adults seeking to deepen their faith.

We are planning to host a couple of sessions, to share our vision and ideas for our ministries with you. These will also provide an opportunity for you to share your ideas with us and see what volunteering opportunities will be available to help make our vision a reality.

Please do come and say hello after Mass and we look forward to meeting you and supporting you as we establish our work in the parish.
