SECOND COLLECTION

Next Sunday's second collection will be in support of the Catholic Education Service (CES) which acts on behalf of the Catholic Bishops' Conference to support Catholic education. They have a strong and positive relationship with the British and Welsh Governments sharing the aims of high academic standards for all and increased parental choice. Catholic schools make up 10% of the national total of maintained schools. The Catholic Church and Church of England together provide one third of all of the schools in the country. The CES is the chief negotiating and advisory body on matters affecting all aspects of Catholic education, and it also provides financial assistance for school transport in rural areas. We would ask those who had signed bankers' orders to check if their bank has actioned the order 25 requested as we cannot do that on your behalf. If all those pledges are fulfilled, then there is potential for a further £1,735 per month. If you had intended to make a pledge and have not done so - it is never too late forms are still available at the

back of the church.

If all the current pledges are fulfilled, we could anticipate an additional £70,000 per year which goes a very long way to meeting our anticipated deficit on day to day running costs of £80,000. It would be wonderful if we could achieve that target.

The Finance Committee is most grateful for all the donations received, whatever the size, to help running this very active parish. A full report on all aspects of the appeal will be reported in the October Edgeways edition.
