Baptism of the Lord

Canon John, Frs Joe and Denis and Deacons Julian and Sean wish you and your family every blessing for the New Year. It is a time for new beginnings, and whether we make resolutions or not, we have entered a new stage in our journey of faith. This is reflected in the liturgy we celebrate today on the feast of the Baptism of Our Lord. The baptism of Our Lords marks the acceptance by God of his Son, and the mission he has to bring the Good News of our salvation

It reminds us of our own baptism when we



children became God, able to call him Father and anticipate a place with him in his eternal home. The baptism of John was one of repentance, the baptism of Jesus one of water and the Holy Spirit. Jesus needed neither baptism but chose to witness to all the coming down of the Spirit upon him, and his acceptance that 'This is my beloved

Son in whom I am well pleased'. Our liturgies are grounded in the living Word of God, and for the remaining months of the year we will be focusing on the place the words of God in scripture has in our lives, both as individuals and as a worshipping community. On the altar we have a copy of the Bible ready for any of us to read and make those words our own. There will be many different ways offered to us to deepen of love of God's strengthening our relationship with him in this 'Year of the Word'.
