CHANGES AFTER JULY 19TH

With nearly all restrictions being lifted and no restrictions on group sizes for attending communal worship from Monday 19 July, there will be a few changes in the church:

Track and trace via paper forms or the NHS app will still be available.

For your continued safety, we will be keeping alternate pews but removing the string from the middle of pews, mainly to allow easier access for Communion. Please continue to respect other parishioners with social distancing and wearing face masks. Communion will be given under one kind and those who wish to receive on the tongue can do so.

There will be no Communion marshalling for weekday Masses, but we will try and continue with this, if we have enough volunteer stewards at Saturday 6.30, Sunday 10am, 12noon, 5pm and 8pm Masses.

Exposition will be on Wednesday and Fridays after the 10am until noon and from 5.30-6.20pm.

Confessions will currently continue in both Fr John's confessional and in the back chapels from 10.30-11.30am and 6-6.20pm on Saturdays and 6-6.20pm Monday - Friday.

Sunday Masses: Vigil Mass on Saturday at 6.30pm, Sunday Masses at 10am, 12noon, 5pm and 8pm.

Masses will also continue to be live streamed daily including Sundays on <u>https://www.churchservices.tv/Wimbledon.</u>

CATHOLIC CERTIFICATE IN RELIGIOUS STUDIES (CCRS)

'Learn in person, by distance learning or online!'; the Catholic Certificate in Religious Studies (CCRS) is managed and awarded by the Board of Religious Studies on behalf of the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales. It was introduced in 1991 to replace its predecessors, The Catholic Teachers' Certificate and the Certificate in Religious Education. Any person who is or wishes to be involved in Catholic education and formation may apply for this course. This includes those involved in Religious Education in schools, Parish Catechesis and other ministries in the Church and anyone who wishes to follow the course for faith development or personal interest. The course seeks to ensure that participants have at least a basic knowledge and understanding of the beliefs of the Catholic Faith. It also provides a basis for further study.
