

CHANGES AFTER JULY 19TH

With nearly all restrictions being lifted and no restrictions on group sizes for attending communal worship since Monday 19 July, there will be a few changes in the church:

Track and trace via paper forms or the NHS app will still be available and is encouraged.

All decisions made for the church are as per the Government guidelines and the Diocese and depend on the rate of infection in the area, this information will be revised weekly.

- Stewarding will still be done at Communion on Saturday evenings and Sundays. Stewarding is no longer by rota but purely voluntarily, i.e. there may not be enough stewards at weekend Masses (and people to help clean the church after Sat 6.30pm and Sun Masses) as it will be up to the individual to make themselves known/decide if they wish to man the table at the door.
- · Upper Hall will only be used should there be an overflow in the church
- The capacity that the church will take at present is 160
- · There will be no sign of peace
- · Bidding Prayers will continue
- · After the end of the general Communion, Communion will be given on the tongue
- · No Holy water in the fonts

- · Candles will be allowed to be lit
- · Statues can be touched but not kissed
- · Incense can be used
- · Readers need not sanitise before and after reading
- · Collections will continue via the Sum-up machines at the back of the church.
- · All being well with the local situation, the Choir hope to return for the 12 noon Mass on Sunday 5 September, as will music at the 5pm Mass. Congregational singing will be gradually re-introduced at the 10am and 12 noon Masses with single-use hymn sheets from this Sunday.
- · The use of the mask is not compulsory, but would be strongly encouraged in the church.
- · Sanitising of hands when entering the church is important.

Exposition will be on Wednesday and Fridays after the 10am until noon and from 5.30-6.20pm.

Confessions will currently continue in both Fr John's confessional and in the back chapels from 10.30-11.30am and 6-6.20pm on Saturdays and 6-6.20pm Monday - Friday.

Sunday Masses: Vigil Mass on Saturday at 6.30pm, Sunday Masses at 10am, 12noon, 5pm and 8pm.

Masses will also continue to be live streamed daily including Sundays on https://www.churchservices.tv/Wimbledon.

CATHOLIC CERTIFICATE IN RELIGIOUS STUDIES (CCRS)

'Learn in person, by distance learning or online!'; the Catholic Certificate in Religious Studies (CCRS) is managed and awarded by the Board of Religious Studies on behalf of the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales. It was introduced in 1991 to replace its predecessors, The Catholic Teachers' Certificate and the Certificate in Religious Education. Any person who is or wishes to be involved in Catholic education and formation may apply for this course. This includes those involved in Religious Education in schools, Parish Catechesis and other ministries in the Church and anyone who wishes to follow the course for faith development or personal interest. The course seeks to ensure that participants have at least a basic knowledge and understanding of the beliefs of the Catholic Faith. It also provides a basis for further study.
