Thirteenth Week in Ordinary Time Vol. III psalter week I

TODAY'S MASS:

VIGIL MASS (Saturday 6.30pm)

First Reading (Acts 3:1-10): St Peter heals the man who had been crippled from birth.

The **Psalm** (Ps 18:2-5) is a traditional one for use on a Feast of Apostles.

Second Reading (Gal 1:11-20): If St Peter was foremost in confessing the faith, St Paul was foremost in preaching it. And what he preaches is the revelation of Jesus Christ.

Gospel (Jn 21:15-19): St Peter three times professes his love for Jesus, but the Lord predicts Peter's martyrdom for following Him.

MASS OF THE DAY

First Reading (Acts 12:1-11): The angel of God saves Peter from Herod's prison.

Psalm (Ps 33:2-9 R.v5): This is a song for martyrs. St John Fisher recited part of it on the scaffold.

Second Reading (2 Tim 4:6-8.17-18): clearly feeling near the end of his life, Paul states that God has saved him from all the evils he has experienced and will save him for eternal life.

Gospel (Mt 16:13-19): St Peter recognises Jesus at the Christ, the Son of the living God. In turn, in a famous play on words, Jesus says that Peter (which means 'rock') will be the rock upon which the church is to be built.
