TODAY'S MASS:

First Reading (Ezk 2:2-5): This is but one example of how throughout Old Testament times the people of God rejected the prophets he sent.

Psalm (Ps 122): Let us sing or say this psalm in acknowledgement that we have at times rejected God and his messengers.

Second Reading (2 Cor12:7-10): St Paul mentions the 'thorn in the flesh' he received, to stop him becoming too

proud. Maddeningly, we have no idea what this was.

Gospel (Mk 6:1-6): Jesus' inability to achieve much in His hometown, because of their unbelief, poses challenging questions to us as a parish, as a community of faith. Do we truly have faith in Jesus Christ? Do we recognise him when He comes among us? Are we open to Christ working in our midst? Fr David

FOURTH WORLD DAY OF GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY

'Do not cast me off in my old age' (cf. Ps 71:9): This sincere plea, taken from Psalm 71, is the theme of the Fourth World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly taking place on Sunday 28th July. In his message Pope Francis recognizes the situation of many elderly people today and assures them: 'God never abandons His children, never.' He refers to the elderly as 'the firm foundation' on which 'new' stones can rest, in order to join in erecting a spiritual edifice (cf. I Peter 2:5). Both the 'certainty of God's closeness at every stage of life and the fear of abandonment, particularly in old age and in times of pain,' can be found in the Bible, Pope Francis writes. And these words 'reflect an utterly evident reality, [...] All too often, loneliness is the bleak companion of our lives as elderly persons and grandparents.'
