Fifteenth Week in Ordinary Time Vol. III psalter week 3

TODAY'S MASS:

First Reading (Amos 7:12-15): Despite not being a member of the order of prophets and being merely a shepherd and sycamore tree cultivator, Amos is nonetheless called by God to prophesy.

Psalm (Ps 84:9-14.R.v8): In his mercy God has forgiven us before; now we ask him to forgive us again.

Second Reading (Eph 1:3-14): Today we hear the first in a series of readings from the Letter to the Ephesians, in a beautiful and typically lewish passage about the Blessing of God.

Gospel (Mk 6:7-13): the Twelve are sent out in pairs: they are to travel light, preach repentance, cast out devils, and anoint sick people. As a starting point for reflection, what prevents us nowadays from 'travelling light'? What baggage encumbers the Church in its mission? Are we more concerned for maintenance than mission? How, in 2024, do we witness to the simplicity and trust in Christ shown by the Twelve? Fr David

SEA SUNDAY

The Second Collection today is for Stella Maris (formerly The Apostleship of the Sea), the Catholic charity which supports seafarers worldwide. 90% of world trade is transported by ship, but the life of a seafarer is lonely, away from families for long periods, and can be dangerous. Stella Maris offers practical care, spiritual support (most seafarers are Catholic) and friendship. The charity relies wholly on voluntary contributions and can only continue its work through the generous donations of its supporters, particularly this collection. DIACONATE DAY

The name 'Deacon' comes from the Greek word 'diakonia', which means 'service'. The Diaconal Ministry is a ministry of service with three functions: the ministry of the Word, proclaiming the Gospel, the ministry of the Altar, serving at Holy Mass, and the ministry of charity, caring for the poor and needy. A Permanent Deacon is an Ordained man, married or single, called to assist the Bishop and the local Priest, and the parish. The Diaconate is rooted in Scripture, especially I Timothy 3: 8-12. Are you a man between 21 and 58 years, with a desire to serve God and God's people in the Archdiocese? Please speak to Deacon Julian to find out more.
