Mass starts with the Palm Gospel and the blessing of Palms, and then the Solemn Entrance into the Church. Please follow the Altar party. Please join in the crowd parts (C) in the Passion.

Assemble in Church as normal. After the Palm Gospel and Blessing of Palms please follow the Altar party in Procession out of the South door, along the pavement, and back in the main entrance. Please join in the crowd parts (C) in the Passion.
