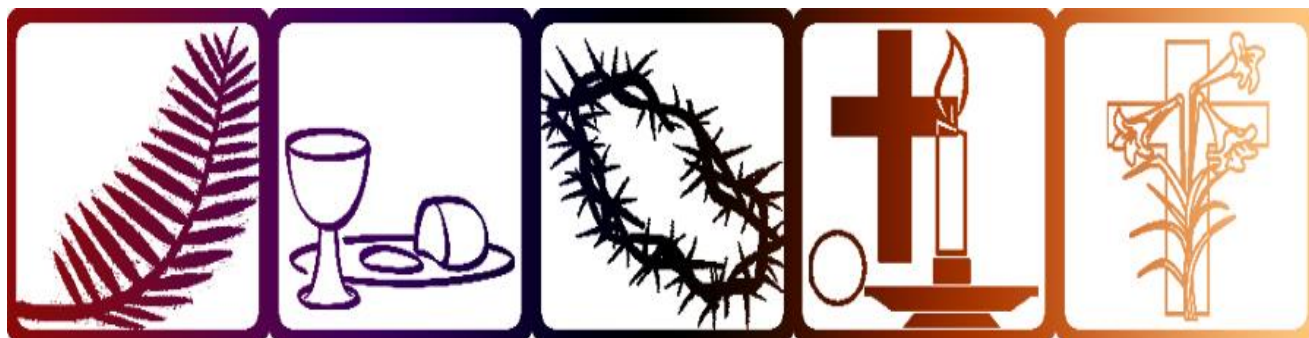

Blessing of the Fire & Procession of the Paschal Candle, the Easter Proclamation (Exsultet), Vigil of Readings, Baptism, Reception & Confirmation of Adults, and Mass of the Resurrection.

This is the most important Liturgy of the Year; attend if you possibly can.
