Today's Mass

Today - Gaudete Sunday - a certain relaxation in our Advent discipline is permitted, and rose-coloured vestments are worn.

While the First Reading (Isaiah 35:1-6a,10) gives hope and courage to the downhearted or restricted, when Isaiah refers to the blind, the lame, etc., he means the whole community. This prophecy is fulfilled in Christ, who came to restore us, as a community of faith, to wholeness and integrity. Psalm 146(145) picks up the same theme.

Second Reading (James 5:7-10): St James says that, like a farmer, we must be patient as we wait for Christ's Second Coming. In the Bible, the harvest is often used as a picture for the Day of Judgment. We should wait patiently for this day and not make judgments ourselves about other people.

Gospel (Matthew 11:2-11): John the Baptist sends his disciples to find out who Jesus is - is He truly the Messiah? Jesus tells them: look at the evidence of your own eyes. He makes the point that in the coming Kingdom of God, the little ones who believe in Him will have the same standing as important figures like John.

Reserved seats for Christmas Eve Masses: The front four rows of seats on the left-hand centre aisle (Ambo-side) of the church will be reserved for frail and elderly persons and wheelchairs, until 5 minutes before the Carols begin. Thereafter, they will be available to everyone.

Parking: Additional car parking spaces will be available at Wimbledon College from 3.00pm on Wednesday 24 December until 2.00am on Thursday 25 December. The parking registration system in the church car park will be deactivated for Masses on Wednesday 24, Friday 25, Saturday 26, and Wednesday 31 December, and Thursday 1 January.

Collection at Christmas Masses: By diocesan rule, the Collection at all Christmas Masses is your gift to the priests of the parish.

Crib Offerings: The Christmas Crib will be displayed in the St Ignatius Chapel. Please take care when lighting votive candles, especially around children. The Crib Offerings will be sent to the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem, earmarked for medical and humanitarian needs, via the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem, of which Canon David is a Knight Commander. They will support humanitarian aid convoys, enable the provision of schooling and clinics, and help to rebuild communities devastated in the Holy Land. Aid will get to where it is most needed.

Parish Office Christmas closure: Please note that the Parish Office will be closed from Wednesday 24 until Sunday 28 December inclusive. It will reopen for Monday 29 and Tuesday 30 December, then close again from Wednesday 31 December until Sunday 4 January 2026 inclusive.
