A Need to Pray

On the day when we should be celebrating the gift of our mothers, this Mothering Sunday, we mourn the death of one mum and we grieve with her children and the other children of the families of the other three victims of terrorist attack Wednesday. Once again we are challenged by the evil actions of one man intent on bringing death and destruction to the streets of London. Our first act as Christian men and women is to pray. We pray first for the victims of the violence that they may find rest with the Lord and hear those most consoling words of Christ, "Come you, whom my Father has blessed, inherit the kingdom prepared for you since the foundation of the world." Our second prayer needs to be for



those injured in the attack and especially for those who are fighting for their lives. We pray that they will be given strength to come through and be reunited with their families. Let us also pray for the family and friends of those killed and injured in the events of Wednesday, that in their sorrow and grief they will find strength and support to help them through this terrible time. Our prayer then must be for our community here in London that as a city and a nation

we find strength not to sink to the same level as the attacker but be strong and united in our determination to act justly and continue to work for a united and peaceful society. Our final prayer needs to be the prayer of Christ on the Cross, "Father forgive them for they know not what they do". Our prayer for forgiveness is central to our faith as we recall the words of the Lord's prayer, "Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." Forgiveness is always hard. it is always demanding, but it always shows the strength of the one who forgives. Finally today our prayer must be for our mums. in thanks for all they do for us in their generosity and love.
